




The Wicked Wine of Democracy: A Memoir of a Political Junkie 1948-1995

Magnuson, Henry 'Scoop' Jackson, Frank Church, William Proxmire, and, finally, John F. Kennedy. After Kennedy's victory, Miller opened a lobbying office on Capitol Hill. In this always revealing and often humorous memoir, "Smilin' Joe" Miller reports on the highlights and back room conversations to give an honest picture of how politics worked.
