In this novel the case for alternative authorship is put forward from the perspective of a close friend of Branwells, the barber and poet George McCraw. The book features a letter sent by McCraw to the Halifax Courier in 1861, and uses this as a basis to delve into the barbers life in Victorian Bradford, the murky and polluted world of the city providing a suitably macabre backdrop for the events which unfold. The reader follows McCraw as he relives his past and present in a quest to reveal the true authorship of the work. Another interesting edge...
