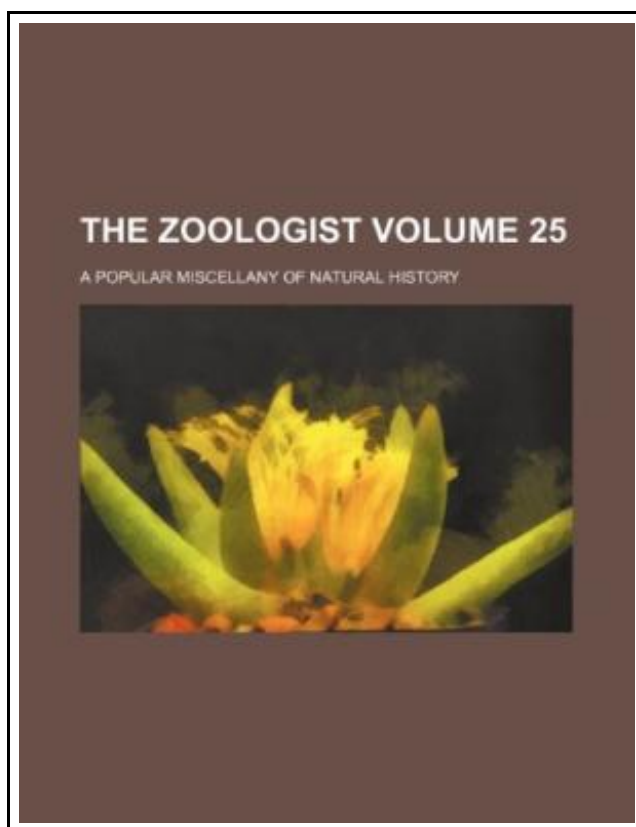

It would be unnecessary to quote White of Selbornes well-known account of how a shrewwash was made, viz. by plugging the unfortunate creature up in a hole bored in an ash-tree, the twigs of which were henceforth endowed with the power of curing the shrew-struck, that is, those who had been unlucky enough to be touched by this ravening beast. The Rev. J. Wood quotes an old author named Topsel (1658), who prescribes various other remedies; Jirst, the earth of a cart-road, which is fatal to them; secondly, the shrew, which by falling by chance into a cart-rode or track, doth die upon the same, is to be burned, beaten to dust, mixed with goose-grease, and used as an ointment. The preparations were for the injuries caused by the animal itself, but other formulas were specifics for fellons or biles, imposterms and the bite of a greedy and ravenous dog (Wood, Popular Natural History vol. i. p. 435).
