

The hills of Ingleborough and Penygant are visible from Morecambe Bay. Between the Bibble and the Mersey extends the Lancashire coalfield, corresponding in latitude with the Yorkshire coalfield on the other side of the Pennines. Skirting the coast and the edge of the coalfield is the red sandstone plain, which opens out in the plain of Cheshire, probably concealing a coalfield below. The Weaver drains this plain, which is famous for its salt deposits. The up-raised Staffordshire moorlands cut it off from the contiguous basin of the Trent. The flat coastlands of Lancashire on either side of the Bibble are covered with alluvium. The Lancashire coalfield is interrupted by the uplifting of the underlying millstone grit, with the result that twogroups of industrial towns have arisen--one to the north towards the Bibble, the other to the south, towards the Mersey. The rainfall is greater than on the corresponding Yorkshire coalfield. The damper climate, which is due to more than average rainfall on a clayey soil, suits the cotton industry, of which this coalfield is the centre. Agriculture thrives on the plain; pasture is good on the Pennine spurs. The Lune and the Upper Kibble are famed for their scenery. Ingleborough, Penygant, and Whernside, the highest points in the Pennine Chain (except Crossfell), all stand near the source of the Ribble. Settle and Ingleton are favourite tourist centres in that limestone region. They both lie on the track of the Midland Railway...
